Storm Clean Up Reminder

As a reminder the curbside and drop-off storm clean up begins today, August 2, 2023. This is only for limbs and branches that have fallen during the storm. This clean up DOES NOT include trash, debris, furniture, or any other household waste. Other waste will need to be disposed of properly. Large non-yard waste pickups can be scheduled through Republic Services by calling 800-631-1156.

Original Press Release Dated July 31, 2023 - The City of Centralia would like to inform residents about the available clean-up options following the recent storm that impacted our community. We are committed to providing the necessary support during this time.

Clean-Up Options:

Curbside Pickup: Beginning Wednesday August 2nd through August 16th, City crews will be conducting curbside pickup of limbs and yard waste. Please follow the guidelines below for a smooth collection process:

- Place limbs and yard waste at the front curb in manageable piles (there will not be alley pickup).
- Bundle branches if possible.
- Do not place trash, construction, or hazardous materials with the yard waste.

Drop-Off Site: For those who prefer to deliver yard waste directly, the City has set up designated drop-off site at 100 Johnson St. (Intersection of Johnson and Walnut).

- This site will be operational from August 2nd – August 11th from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday thru Friday.
- This is for Centralia residents only. Please be prepared to provide proof of address such as an ID or utility bill with a Centralia address. Non-residents or contractors will not be allowed to dispose of yard waste.
- Do not dump yard waste outside of the fenced area at any time.

Burning: As a reminder August 5th and 6th and August 12th and 13th are scheduled burn dates from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Only yard waste can be burnt during this specified time.
